free-form CV	<p>Brankica Ban (Hincak) was born in Vukovar. After finishing secondary school, she enrolled the Faculty of Music in Belgrade, she graduated in Music Studies in 1986. In 1985 she started working in Secondary music school Franjo Kuhač in Osijek and since 1992, besides her teaching activities, she has been involved in organisation, scientific and research activities. She has participated in numerous music conferences in Croatia (11) and abroad (4). She participated in the research project Revitalisation and protection of the instrument Physaccordion Peter Titz from the 19th century, Institute for Scientific and Artistic work in Osijek, Đakovo and Osijek Diocese and Parish St. Michael Archangel in May 26 2006, which was a contribution to Croatian organ instrument studies. She has published three books: Music culture of Vukovar – the culture of Croatian national identity (1995), monograph Music school Franjo Kuhač – history and life (1996) and Archive records of Vukovar Franciscan Monastery. She has also published papers in monographs related to the history of Osijek: Music school 1918–1945 in the monograph From Turkish to Contemporary Osijek; Music in Osijek and the Region, entry in the Croatian Encyclopaedia (1998); Croatian biography lexicon (entry on Ivan Nepomuk Hummel). She regularly publishes papers in music journals (Art musices).</p> <p>She graduated in 1986, (thesis Traditional and evolutionary in Petar Stojanović's concerts, advisor Vlastimir Peričić). She defended her Master's thesis in 2010 at the Academy of Music in Zagreb (thesis Music life in Osijek portrayed through activities of music associations in the parish church of St. Michael Archangel in Tvrđa, advisor Vjera Katalinić). She obtained her PhD at the Doctoral School at the University of Osijek in 2015 (thesis Archive records of Vukovar Franciscan Monastery, advisors Stanislav Marijanović, professor emeritus at the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences in Osijek and Davor Bobić, full professor at the Academy of Arts in Osijek).</p>
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
