free-form CV	Helena Sablić Tomić was born in Osijek where she finished the primary and secondary schools and completed her studies at the Faculty of Philosophy. At the Faculty of Philosophy in Zagreb, she was awarded the MA degree (thesis: The Short Story of the 90s – the publications and authors of the Quorum journal) in 1997 and the PhD degree (thesis: The Models of Contemporary Croatian Autobiographical Prose) in 2001. At the Academy of Arts and Culture, she is a tenured full professor, teaching courses in literature and culture. She is the first ambassador of Creative Europe Desk of the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Croatia. She is the author of 19 books and over a hundred scientific papers.
