His work was featured at many group exhibitions in Croatia and abroad and he has held 21 independent exhibitions. He is the author of the public monuments of M.A. Reljković, Josip Runjanin, Krunoslav Tkalac, Marija and Ivan Kozarac, Matija Gubec, and the following statues presented as awards: "Spiritual oak" at the "Poetry encounters" manifestation in Drenovci, "Satyr" at the "Actors festival" manifestation and the statue "Masks" at the "Theater creativity gathering in Retkovci" Manifestation.

	<p>He is familiar with symbolism, minimalism as well as conceptual art.</p> <p>He has worked as a pedagogue for art since 1989, and as a professor at the art academy in Osijek since 2008.</p> <p>He is the art lead of 7 art colonies, leader of the art section of the Matrix Croatica branch in Vinkovci. Since 2009 he has been the set designer for Vinkovačke Jeseni, a manifestation of international and national value, a member of organisational committee for creativity in theatre in the Vukovar-Srijem county as well as a set designer of the "Mika Živković" theatre in Retkovci.</p>
