Đuro Tikvica.</p> <p>He performs as a soloist, accompanist and a member of chamber ensembles, and also regularly plays with Croatian National Theatre Orchestra in Osijek (Chopin 2nd Piano Concerto, a premiere performance of the „Kings and Grooms“ Opera...). He accomplished some remarkable performances in about thirty cities in Croatia, Italy, Hungary, Slovenia, Serbia and Bosnia & Herzegovina, and his wide repertoire consists of works by composers from Baroque to contemporary. He performed several times at „Days of Milko Kelemen“, international festival that brings together top musicians from around the world for the last twenty years. He has been the official accompanist of the International Singing Competition Lav Mirski in Osijek since 2015.
