She graduated Piano at the free-form CV Music Academy of the University of Zagreb. Her professional development has been done among the most eminent piano pedagogues. She obtained the academic degree Doctor of Educational Sciences with the subject in the field of piano teaching methodology: Piano teachers' assessment of the competencies required to teach piano at music schools. She had worked in Franjo Kuhač Music School in Osijek as a piano teacher and an accompanist. Since 2008 she has been working at the Academy of Arts, today known as the Academy of Arts and Culture in Osijek. She teaches Piano (obligatory), and from the academic year 2018/2019 Piano Class Methodology and Pedagogical Practice. Her piano students are winners of first prizes on international competitions. She is interested in artistic and scientific work, and her interests also lie in the field of piano teaching methods, piano teacher education, as well as the playing teaching history. She has been a lecturer at international scientific conferences, and she has been invited as a lecturer on professional and scientific gatherings. She is the author of scientific works on piano teacher education, instrument music pedagogy and subjects which deal with the history of piano playing in Croatia. She is the reviewer of scientific papers and the book Piano Class Methodology. She was the artistic director of the 9th Music Christmas Festivities, and on the organizing committee of the 1st Scientific and Art International Symposium on Pedagogy in the Arts.
