<p>free-form CV</p>	<p>(Born in 1991) Assistant Professor at the Department of Culture, Media and Management and Secretary General of the University Centre for Integrative Bioethics, as a scientific unit of the Scientific Centre of Excellence for Integrative Bioethics, which by definition brings together internationally most successful Croatian bioethics scholars and scientists. His field of work are: legal theory and philosophy, bioethics (especially biomedical law and ethics), culture in law (as well as law in culture), within which he frequently exhibits at national and international scientific conferences.</p> <p>After graduating from the Jesuit Classical Gymnasium in Osijek, in 2010 he enrolls in the Law Faculty of the University of J.J. Strossmayer in Osijek where he graduated in 2015 and completed the Legal Linguistics Professional Development Program. During her studies he participated in a large number of conferences, seminars, law schools and competitions (in the Netherlands, Germany, Austria, Italy, Hungary, Croatia, BiH and Serbia). Most notable are: the 50th anniversary of the signing of the Elysee Agreement in the Berlin's Bundestag (Reichstag), where he participated as a young Croatian representative with numerous European political officials (Chancellor Angela Merkel and President François Hollande) and a project by the French and German governments War Crimes and Trials where he professionally resides at the United Nations International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia in The Hague (ICTY). Also, after finishing the Regional Law School in international criminal and humanitarian law at the Faculty of Political Sciences in Belgrade (2012), as part of the team of the Faculty of Law of University of J.J. Strossmayer sin Osijek, in Sarajevo (2012) he participates in an international competition in the same field organized by the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC) and the Embassy of the Swiss Confederation in BiH.</p> <p>He has been awarded with the Rector's Award, twice the Dean's Award for Excellence and twice was the recipient of a University Scholarship for the University's most successful students. He is fluent in English (active) and German (passive) and uses Latin (1st foreign language of the State Matura Exam, A level) and Ancient Greek in his scientific work.</p>
